

Parents:

Please read these rules and regulations over with your child. Both you and your child will be required to sign before they can attend the summer program.

1. Meadowbrook will not be held responsible for any injuries that occur due to misbehavior.
2. There is no toleration of disrespect before, during and after field trips. This includes, but is not limited to: spitting, hitting, yelling, talking back, fighting, and kicking.
3. There will be absolutely no misbehaving while in the van on the way to the field trip or any other time. This includes, yelling at the driver, standing, and not buckling their seatbelt. Children also must wait until the van has come to a complete stop before unbuckling their seatbelt.
4. Children must follow directions that are given by staff members or the person who is in charge of the facility that we attend (i.e. lifeguard, event staff).
5. The Children must participate in the field trip; under no circumstances will school-age children stay at the center, while the other children are on the trip. The only exceptions is if their trip is taken away or tuition is not paid.
5. Our field trips are a privilege. Children must earn the right to go.

If any of these rules are broken, Meadowbrook staff has the right to make a child sit out and/or miss a field trip. When a child loses a trip, the teacher that took the trip away, will chose what trip they will miss. They will not be able to earn this back.
